STOLA Philosophy and Policies

- 1. Every dog has the right to a safe, loving home.
- 2. The welfare of the dog always comes first. No exceptions. All decisions made about the disposition of the dog must support this belief.
- 3. When a dog is in need, the first order of business is to move the dog to a safe location, i.e. veterinarian, boarding kennel or foster home as the situation dictates.
- 4. When the dog has been placed in a safe location, every attempt should be made to locate the dog's legal owner/breeder.
- 5. No dog will ever be placed in an abusive or neglectful environment for any reason. If the legal owner/ breeder of the dog is found to have an abusive or neglectful environment then the dog will not be returned to that environment and the volunteer will contact STOLA Support Council. Together they will investigate all legal means of protecting the dog. The welfare of the dog is always the first priority.
- 6. If, after a reasonable period of time, the legal owner/breeder cannot be located, then the dog will be neutered or spayed before being placed in a pre-screened adoptive home.
- 7. All volunteers operate under the supervision of their Regional Coordinator and Support Council.
- 8. All communications and actions will be based on compassion, integrity and respect.
- 9. Each situation is different; flexibility is essential. Volunteers are encouraged to use their discretion in rehoming situations, keeping in mind that the welfare of the dog comes first.
